What is PARCC??- Computer based, Common Core aligned English/Language Arts and Math assessments. The core of PARCC is to create usable K-12 digital assessments for schools, educators and students to accelerate and enhance learning. Funded by a Race to the Top federal grant, 22 states are working together to create a tool to mark student's progress from 3rd grade to college ready. This assessment will be ready to



administer during the 2014-2015 school year. PARCC assessments will be device neutral, and will include both traditional multiple choice and performance-based assessments.

PARCC States

Collectively the states in PARCC educate about 24 million students. The PARCC states include: Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Mississippi, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, and Tennessee.
